Deakin University	Merryn Falk	No specific sessional awards, but sessionals are eligible for Teaching Awards		<p>Deakin University has several internal teaching awards offered by the Vice-Chancellor and the following staff are eligible to apply:</p> <p>All academic staff who hold full-time, fractional, continuing or limited term appointments at Deakin University are eligible to apply for the Deakin University Awards for Teaching Excellence.</p> <p>So sessional staff (or equivalent) would be eligible to apply. Deakin does not have an award specifically for sessional staff, however.</p>

A sessional teacher can often claim in one area well but not all five. It could be - open to all - just providing better options for sessional staff. OR it could make different awards dependent on category of employment</p>
